- X. Discussion
 - a. “Go Green”:Kat O’Lance
 - i. Director of Luther Bean Museum, sustainability, attended ASHY conference-going green, send all notes to all of Senate, recycled t-shirts, smart strips, plastic bottles, bookstore- is it green?, community service- what you can do to help, eco-adventures, exercise equipment- creates power, energy audits, student got involved, how involved is AS&F and student body?, eco-villages, curriculum
 - b. ASF101120: Art League
 - i. 3 credit hour class, funding for only 10 students who have attended all meetings and participated in all events, 13 days, educational tour, increase knowledge, help resume, chance to get out of Alamosa art scene, educate prehistoric art, fundraised \$1,300—haunted house
 - 1. Rep Adams: Where are the fees for class, where is the class cost listed?
 - a. You have to pay for the class, we are asking for the general trip, class cost is included, we are asking for \$6,955 at this time
 - 2. Rep Hargis: Will you be asking for more money at another time?
 - a. Yes, \$20,000 total
