FTAC Summary for 2016/2017

This year, FTAC updated the priority list. Since Degree Works has been purchased and will be implemented within the next year, we replaced that item with a desire to have student photos on course and advising rosters. We have presented that item to ITGovernance and they believe within the next few years with the new OneCard system and the upgrade to Banner 9, we will have the capability to link student's ID photographs with their names in the course roster.

The other big task for the year was the FTAC grant of \$5,000. This year we split the money between five different departments. Teacher Education received \$1,850 to spend on items for a STEM Lab. Biology received \$1,400 for cameras to research animal movement in the wild, HPPE received \$365 for an App called GYMAWARE Powertool used to monitor power velocities and power outputs, and Art received \$1,350 for a mobile digital lab.

I included the current members who regularly attended FTAC below. Tim Armstrong has indicated that he will serve on FTAC next year. Psychology will need a new representative and HPPE has not had a representative sitting on FTAC during my tenure as chair. Several other departments did not have an active member serving on FTAC this past year as well. Additionally, I will be stepping down this year, so Senate will need to identify a new chair beginning in the Fall.
